This year we had five crews on the water. Two U19's, the Vets and U23 men and U23 women.

The season started well with a first to the U19 mirrors, and a second to the U23 women in the Garie Dash at Bundeena.



The crews competed in the State Titles at Swansea Belmont without any luck. The two U19 crews and the U23 men competed at Collaroy Young Guns, with the U19 mirrors just missing out on the final.

The two U19 crews also rowed in the finals of the Best of The Best Boat Series at Wanda in big seas.

In the Branch Titles we picked up a bronze medal to the U19 mirrors, with the U23 women making the final in both the open and U23 women. The U19 dorights also made the final.

In the South Coast Boat Series, the crews rowed in all four rounds with the U19 dorights best with 3<sup>rd</sup> overall.

All crews travelled to the Gold Coast for the Australian Championships at Kurrawa, with all crews rowing except for the U23 women, due to huge seas and all racing being cancelled due to the death of an ironman competitor.

In the coming season we hope to have at least six crews training and competing. Two U19's, U23 women, U23 men, reserves and vets.

I hope all crews stay keen, and all travel to compete at the Australian Titles on the Gold Coast in 2011.

All items of a minor nature below the cost of \$300 are written off in the year incurred

## **4. LEASEHOLD IMPROVEMENTS**

These improvements were carried out in 2005 and consisted of improvements to the toilets and bathrooms in the clubhouse.

They were funded in part by a government grant

The committee estimates the improvements to have an effective life of 40 years.

## **5 DEPRECIATION**

From the 2008 Financial Year onwards Assets are depreciated as follows:

- Leasehold Improvements are depreciated on a straight line basis over 40 years.
- Motor Vehicles are depreciated using the diminishing value method at 18.5% per year.
- Plant & Equipment are depreciated using the diminishing value method at 15% per year.

Prior to the 2008 Financial Year assets were depreciated as follows:

- Leasehold Improvements were not depreciated
- Plant & Equipment and Motor Vehicles were depreciated on a Straight Line basis over 5 to 15 Years.
